



Art Teacher: Cartooning and Comics Part-time Position

The Brookline Arts Center (BAC) is seeking an art teacher to work with children grades 3-8 for two classes beginning this winter. The teacher will be responsible for providing overall class goals and objectives, developing class content and curriculum and providing a nurturing environment for students. Position may require occasional weekend work as needed. Classes will be held offsite within Brookline Public Schools.

Each student has the opportunity to develop their own narrative. By the end of class, each student develops a working knowledge of character creation, environment design, page layout and visual storytelling.”
